EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget & Management, acting in consonance with RA 11469, known as the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act, issued on April 7, 2020 its Local Budget Circular No. 125, or the Guidelines on the Release and Utilization of the Bayanihan Grant to Cities and Municipalities (BGCML, for brevity);

WHEREAS, the DBM released the total of P30,823,759,246.00 grant to cities and municipalities as one time financial assistance equivalent to one month IRA for FY 2020, to cover additional funding requirements that shall boost the capacity of cities and municipalities in responding to COVID-19 situation, in view of the extended Enhanced Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bamban received a total of Seventeen Million Six Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Twelve Pesos (Php17,628,912.00) as the amount equivalent to its one month IRA for FY 2020, and which is hereby presented for consideration as supplemental budget;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved to enact:

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 02-2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 2, FY 2020 INVOLVING AN AMOUNT OF SEVENTEEN MILLION SIX HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWELVE PESOS (PHP 17,628, 912.00) FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING OF VARIOUS PROJECTS/UNDERTAKINGS IN THE MUNICIPALITY INTENDED TO COMBAT COVID-19 AND TO PROVIDE FOR BASIC SERVICES TO AFFECTED LOCAL POPULATION DURING THE EXTENDED ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (ECQ)

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled, that:

Section 1. The Supplemental Budget No. 02 of the Municipality for Fiscal Year 2020 in the total amount of **Seventeen Million Six Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Twelve (Php 17,628,912.00)** intended for funding of various projects/undertakings in the Municipality as provided under DBM Local Budget Circular No. 125, dated April 7, 2020, is hereby **APPROVED**, subject to the following conditions:

- 1.1. Only good quality rice, healthy, nutritious food preferably fresh vegetables, root crops, poultry, meat, milk for children, among others shall be procured for relief assistance;
- 1.2. Only disinfectant approved and recommended by DOH shall be procured;
- 1.3. Include purchase of washable face masks for distribution to indigent families;

Section 2. The budget document consisting of the following are incorporated herein and made an integral part of this appropriation ordinance:


1. Letter/budget message of Mayor Jose Antonio T. Feliciano dated April 14, 2020 and
2. Statement of Funds/Supplemental Appropriation dated April 14, 2020

Section 3. **Sources and use of funds.** Fund is sourced from "Bayanihan Grant to Cities & Municipalities" in the amount equivalent to one month IRA for FY 2020 of the Municipality. Use of funds is in accordance with DBM LBC No. 125, dated April 7, 2020.

Section 4. **Creation of a Special Account in the General Fund.** For this specific purpose, and in compliance with LBC No. 125, a Special Account in the General Fund (SAGF) is hereby created for easy monitoring and tracking of the utilization of the allocation.

Section 5. **Effectivity.** This appropriation ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Municipal Mayor.


