

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27 Series of 2014

CREATING THE MUNICIPAL MULTI-SECTORAL FOREST PROTECTION COMMITTEE (MMFPC) FOR BAMBAN, PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION AND DEFINING ITS DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

WHEREAS, there is a need to create a local forest protection committee that is multi-sectoral in order to assist in the protection and conservation of the environment, most especially to serve as partner-arm of the DENR in its anti-illegal cutting campaign;

WHEREAS, the creation of a municipal multi-sectoral forest protection committee is mandated under DENR Administrative Order No. 17 dated May 20, 1995 which is the “institutionalization of the Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committees within the DENR System” ;

NOW THEREFORE, I JOSE ANTONIO T. FELICIANO, Municipal Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby create the Municipal Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (MMFPC) for Bamban, to be composed as follows:

FUNCTIONS OF MMFPC:

1. Serve as a collection point for information on illegal forestry activities, tapping the independent networks to which its member's belong;
2. Except for the DENR representative, all other members shall act as deputy forest officers with powers to apprehend violators of forest laws and regulations and confiscate illegal forest products;
3. Act as a special monitoring arm for the CENRO;
4. Act as the CENRO's partner in the implementation of DENR's public awareness program;
5. Participate directly in the identification, formulation and implementation of livelihood programs for upland communities;
6. Mobilize member's networks in support of forest protection activities;
7. Publicize the committee's discussion and findings except where treated as confidential;
