

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30 Series of 2014

**RE-ORGANIZATION OF THE MUNICIPAL LOCAL POVERTY REDUCTION ACTION TEAM (LPRAT)**

**WHEREAS**, the Aquino administration is vigorously pursuing the goal of inclusive growth and poverty reduction by 2016.

**WHEREAS**, the Grassroots Participatory Planning and Budgeting (GB), a strategy of reforms in governance, is being implemented to ensure the inclusion of the funding requirements for the development needs of focus cities and municipalities in the budget proposals for FY 2016 of participating agencies;

**WHEREAS**, to effect the GB implementation, the Local Poverty Reduction Action Teams (LPRATs) will have to be organized to spearhead the formulation and monitoring of the Local Poverty Reduction Plans (LPRAPs);

**WHEREAS**, this LGU plan will contain programs and projects to be collectively drawn through a participatory process with Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) and other stakeholders, and which will directly address the needs of the poor constituencies and the marginalized sectors in the municipality of Bamnan, Tarlac;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Jose Antonio T. Feliciano, Municipal Mayor of Bamnan, Tarlac, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby ordain and decree that:

Section 1. RE-Organization of the Local Poverty Reduction Action Team (LPRAT).

The LPRAT shall be composed of the following:

Section 2.Duties and Responsibilities of the LPRAT. The LPRAT shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- 2.1 Formulate the LPRAP and the identification of priority poverty reduction projects;
- 2.2 Agree on a list of priority poverty reduction projects for 2016 based on the LPRAP and submit it to the RPRAT; and
- 2.3 Conduct quarterly meetings to monitor the status of the approval and integration of the priority poverty reduction projects into the budgets of participating agencies and monitor the implementation and status of the projects.

Section 3. Endorsement of CSOs. The list of priority projects that will be forwarded to the Local Sanggunian shall be signed by the three (3) elected CSO members of the LPRAT on every page.

Section 4. Approval of Sanggunian. The local Sanggunian must also approve the list of priority projects before it is submitted to the national government, through the issuance of a Sanggunian Resolution.

Section 5. Submission of the List of Priority Poverty Reduction Projects. The list of priority poverty reduction projects duly endorsed by the CSOs and approved by the Sanggunian shall be submitted to the RPRAT through the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Regional Office:

The submission should include:

- Cover letter signed by the Municipal Mayor;
- List of Priority Projects, using prescribed format and with all pages signed by the 3 CSO representatives identified;
- Project brief for each proposed project (using prescribed template);
- Copy of Sanggunian Resolution approving the List of Priority Poverty Reduction Projects; and
- Both printed and electronic copies of these documents should be submitted to the DILG Regional Office. Electronic copies should be submitted through e-mail. The list of priority projects must be submitted in both PDFG (scanned) and word/excel (editable) format.

Section 6. Repealing Clause. All executive orders, rules and regulations that are inconsistent therewith shall be deemed revoked, amended and /or amended accordingly.

Section 7. Effectivity, This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
