

**ENDORING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MUNICIPAL RECOVERY FACILITY (MRF)  
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAMBAN IN COMPLIANCE WITH RA 9003**

WHEREAS, RA 9003, otherwise known as "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000" mandates the establishment of material recovery facility (MRF) by every local government unit:

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 01, series of 2005 already identified a material recovery facility for the municipality, but it was not operated and was eventually scrapped:

NOW THEREFORE, on joint motion of Councilor Ernesto P. Go and Councilor July A. Vitug, unanimously seconded:

BE IT RESOLVED, that acting favorably on the request of the Municipal Mayor as expressed in his letter to the Sangguniang Bayan dated November 21, 2014, this Body hereby endorses the establishment of a Material Recovery Facility (MRF) in the municipality, subject however, to the following conditions:

1. That the facility shall accept only municipal waste of Bamban;
2. That the facility shall not accept hazardous or toxic waste for treatment;
3. That it shall be located in an environmentally safe area; and
4. That Municipal Ordinance No. 01, series of 2005 (Solid waste segregation ordinance) be implemented to complement the operation of the proposed MRF
